It has been quite a journey this year. In order to promote our genetics and the Herd Builder Classic, we have shown in over 20 shows in eight states. Perhaps our best show was the Wisconsin State Fair where our buck, RBGO Bad Ass, was awarded Grand Champion Overall. ABGA judges consistently comment on his breed character. RBGO Bad Ass is a flush son of Yata-Hey, a Bo Jangle son we purchased as an outcross. Yata-Hey is proving to be quite a general purpose buck. He also produced the Overall Grand Champion wether shown by the Starzynski family at the Michigan State Fair. It seems clean fronts and powerful loins are desirable in both bucks and wethers. In addition, our consignors have promoted and shown in an additional 20 plus shows.

Mention should be made of the success of Redgate, Johnson Farm and Rising Star Boer Farm. Once again Redgate has had a Grand or Reserve, and often both, in every ABGA show they have shown. Also, Johnson Farm's buck, Tri-F Farms Maximum Return, produced the Kentucky State Fair Overall Grand Champion buck. And not least, the Manning's bred the Overall Grand Champion wether at the Erie County Fair in Buffalo, New York, one of the top 10 fairs in the nation. The wether was out of Rising Star's new herd sire, Polar's Built Tough and was show by the Knoll family. These are accomplishments of note and are mentioned to assure our clientele that we continue to meet the highest needs of the industry.
